### Downriver Attorney Randall Pentiuk named to Legislative Advocacy Committee

The International Municipal Lawyers Association (IMLA), an organization of city, township and county attorneys in the United States and Canada, has named Randall Pentiuk to its Legislative Advocacy Committee for the 2007-2008 year. In this capacity, Mr. Pentiuk will work to promote the concerns of municipal governments throughout the country in Congress and the States.
