**Re: Kerry L. Morgan Settles Case for the Michigan Association of Scholars**

Downriver attorney Kerry L. Morgan has successfully settled on behalf of the Michigan Association of Scholars, their suit against the University of Michigan. MAS sued the University to divulge the data used in the Gratz and Grutter v. Bollinger admissions lawsuits. The University repeatedly denied MAS access to the raw data. Shortly after the Supreme Court's actual decision, Morgan filed suit to compel the University to produce the data .
